NBP Distributes Food Packets For Flood Affected People In Matli

August 24, 2011: NBP being nation's bank discharges its social responsibility duties and is always in service of nation in times of need. With a view to help affectees of the massive devastation caused by floods, NBP distributed food packets among residents of Matli, comprising of Flour, Mineral water, Ghee, tea, sugar & other kitchen items amounting Rs. 1500/- (approx) per bag serving 5-6 members family for a week. NBP will distribute 5000 such packets.

The camp was visited by Mr. Tariq Latif Ansari, SVP, Regional Head, NBP, Hyderabad Region and Mr. Mir Babu Talpur, MPA of PPP, Matli and other volunteers of NBP. Mr. Tariq Latif Ansari expressed his deep concern for the sufferings of the people who have been displaced from their homes as a result of the floods and further said that in this hour of need, NBP is standing shoulder to shoulder with the people.

Apart from distribution of food packets, NBP has also organized the free medical relief camps initially for ten days, three days in Kario Ganhwar District Badin; one day in Matli District Badin; two days in Drigri District Mirpur Khas, one day in Jaati Chwok district Thatta and three days in Tando Muhamamd Khan District. Specialists and consultant doctors of skin, gynea, eye, neuro and other specialists have been attending the patients. Flood affectees are given free medicines, treatment and consultation.
